 - That Govt. Mominee in the Managing Committee will be asked for immeditaly and all dicision will be taken as mentioned in the approved Managing Committee as in the approved Scheme of Management by DDE (ACT).

 - 20, That no unrecognised class shall be run in the school premises. Mursery classes may not run in the school building.

- 22. Violation of any instructions/provision/conditions/rules & regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school and class IX shall not be opened without the prior approval of the Director of Education, Delhi.
